The committee and I hope you have had a lovely summer break and are raring to go for the season ahead.


This is just a quick newsletter to give you a few updates about the new season and the indicative schedule to see us up to Christmas.

With this in mind the committee has decided to make some changes for next years competition, these are listed below to make them very clear to everyone.

- 1. There will now be three divisions, not two.
- 2. The scoring will not change this season with all entries marked out of ten.
- 3. Your average score per entry from last season will determine what division you are placed in.
- 4. The top 2 divisions will have 12 photographers in, the remainder will be in the final division.
- 5. There will be print, PDI and overall winners awarded for each division.

Why have we done this? Feedback from members felt that with varying levels of photography skill within the club that beginners or people evolving their camera skills were a little left out when it came to competitions.
